Intent

As set out in <u>Section 4. (1)4. of Ontario Regulation 27/13</u> (the Registration Regulation), it is a requirement of this College that applicants be able to speak, read, and write either English or French with reasonable fluency. This policy is intended to outline the criteria that will be used by the College to determine if an applicant meets this language fluency requirement of the College.

Policy

Applicants to the College will be deemed to have met the language fluency requirement of the College if they have met one of the following:

- The applicant signs a self-declaration on the application form confirming that the applicant's first language is English or French;
- The applicant successfully completes the Safety Program Test, Jurisprudence Course Test, and Registration Examination in either English or French;
- The applicant submits an original or notarized copy of a transcript showing graduation from a secondary school with four consecutive, first language English or French credits at the secondary school level;
- The applicant submits an original or notarized copy of a transcript and degree showing completion of an undergraduate degree from a recognized public university or college in English or French;

OR

• The applicant is able to demonstrate their fluency through an in-person interview with the Registrar or panel of the Registration Committee.
